

PUBLIC HEALTH HOME VISITS

Contracted towns can refer residents to a short-term support service that is separate from skilled homecare or hospice. This service is for individuals who want to remain safely in their homes, are cognitively intact, and are open to feedback from the VNA Public Health team. The team helps residents navigate healthcare, connects them with community resources, and provides short-term support to maintain independence at home.

TOWN NURSE home visits include

- Medication management
- Advanced directives assistance
- Patient & caregiver education
- Direct Observation Therapy
- Diabetes support



PHYSICAL THERAPIST home visits include

- Patient & caregiver education
- DME recommendations
- Home safety assessment
- Exercise prescription
- Gait & transfer training
